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Detailed itinerary

Day 1

Arrival at the airport and transfer to the hotel in Tbilisi. From this very moment, your acquaintance with Georgia will start. In recent years, more and more tourists from around the world are choosing Georgia as an attractive tourist destination. Its fantastic mountain landscapes, unique culture and mouth-watering national cuisine don't leave anyone indifferent. With the help of our professional guide, you will plunge into the local culture and reveal lots of secrets. After your check-in at the hotel, you can stroll around the city centre, have a cup of coffee in the cosy cafes and feel the hospitality of Tbilisi.

Overnight: Hotel in Tbilisi

Day 2

Tbilisi city tour is the best way of discovering this cozy city and our first stop is Tsminda Sameba –the highest temple in Georgia. Then trip continues to the historical district of Metekhi to explore the Assumption Church located on the picturesque hill. We reach the fortress Narikala by the cable car to enjoy breathtaking panoramic view of Tbilisi. After, we have some great walking around the Old Town and visit Meydan Square and sulfur baths (XVII-XIX centuries). No trip in Tbilisi is complete without strolling around cozy Shardeni Street with cafes, boutiques and fashionable galleries. Tbilisi city tour also includes a visit to Sioni church where is kept one of the greatest relics of Georgia - the cross of St. Patriarchate. Our day ends with a trip to Mtatsminda Mount by the funicular railway.

Overnight: Hotel in Tbilisi **Meals:** Breakfast

Day 3

After breakfast, we head to Ananuri Fortress - one of the most attractive sights along the Georgian Military Highway. Then the trip leads us to Gudauri – popular ski resort which is beautiful in any season. On our way to Kazbek we visit Sour waters of Vedza. Dramatically sited at the foot of Kazbek, Trinity Church Gergeti (14th century) is a site not to be missed. Our tour continues to the Dariali Gorge. Located at the border between Georgia and Russia, Dariali George is 1800 m deep canyon with steep granite cliffs hardly letting sunlight down to the bottom. *Overnight: Hotel in Tbilisi*

Meals: Breakfast

Day 4

Today we set out to explore the spiritual heart of Georgia –Mtskheta, a UNESCO World Heritage Site with fascinating mountainous views. Here we enjoy the amazing view of two rivers Mtkvari and Aragvi, explore Jvari Monastery and Svetitskhoveli Cathedral – the first and the main church in Georgia. Tour continues to Gori - one of the most ancient towns in Georgia and Joseph Stalin's birthplace. Our next stop is Kutaisi - Georgia's second largest city and the capital of Imereti.

Overnight: Hotel in Kutaisi **Meals:** Breakfast

Day 5

We start the city tour around Kutaisi visiting Bagrati temple (11th century) named after Bagrat III, the first king of a united Georgia. Tour continues to the Prometheus Cave – one of unique in Europe. Impressive reliefs of stalactites and stalagmites and a variety of underground rivers characterize it. The next treasure on our way is Gelati Monastery - the most valuable cultural landmark and a living symbol of Georgia's Golden Age, protected by UNESCO. Kutaisi city tour





ends with the visit to Motsameta monastery, located in a picturesque and unusual place with a breathtaking view of the hills and the river. Evening back to Tbilisi.

Overnight: Hotel in Tbilisi **Meals:** Breakfast

Day 6

Our today's destination is famous Kakheti – region of ancient traditions and the best wines of Georgia. In this picturesque region we explore one the most important landmarks of Georgia. After, we continue to the famous monastery of Bodbe. Here was buried St. Nino – the founder of Christianity in Georgia. The perfect end of this day is a visit to the city of love Sighnaghi. Here we can stroll around cozy streets in the Italian architectural style and admire colorful carved balconies of red tile-roofed houses.

Overnight: Hotel in Telavi **Meals:** Breakfast

Day 7

The final day is dedicated to exploring Telavi - the capital of Kakheti and the main winemaking region of Georgia. Here we can see 9-hundred-year old tree and after we visit Tsinandali village – the patrimony of famous Georgian family Chavchavadze. The estate is known for its amazing labyrinth planted with exotic trees in it and cellars, where the unique collection of Georgian and European wine is preserved. Our next stop is Batonis Tsikhe - the fortress museum of favorable Georgian King Erekle II. Wine tasting and a master class on baking Georgian bread shoti await us in the famous winery Khareba.

Overnight: Hotel in Tbilisi **Meals:** Breakfast

Day 8

Transfer to the airport, departure.



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Booking conditions

The contract between you and MyGeo is considered confirmed once we received your application, discuss all the details and receive your deposit of \in 50 (per person). Immediately after that, you will receive a tour voucher confirming all the details.
